Preschool and PDO **Policies and Procedures**

Health

The health of all children requires that ill children be kept at home. A child must be fever free (without the use of Tylenol) for 24 hours before returning to school. Also, there should be no signs of vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours before returning to class. A runny nose should be clear, not discolored.

Children requiring an epipen must always have one in the building. A doctor's note must be attached to the epipen. If the epipen is not with the child, he/she cannot stay at school.

No over-the-counter or prescription meds will be administered by staff.

Party and Special Snack Days

Children may celebrate their birthdays at school. Parents need to contact teachers at least one week in advance. Treats may be homemade; however, no cupcakes please. We suggest that you bring cookies and birthday napkins. Celebration of summer birthdays may be arranged with individual teachers. Balloons and candy are not allowed.

For safety reasons, parents **MUST** notify the teacher in writing of food allergies and provide their child's snacks.

Unless all children in the room are invited, **NO** outside of school party invitations will be handed out at school.

Sign up for special snack days will be posted outside the classroom.

Closings

Our school will be closed on days that Noblesville Public Schools are **closed due** to weather conditions. Check local radio and television stations for closings. Parents **will not** be notified by phone. If Noblesville Public Schools is delayed two hours, then all classes will begin at 11:00 am and end at 1:00 pm, except for Extended Day which ends at 2:00 pm. **BE SURE** to pack a lunch for your child on these delayed start days.

Pet Policy

No pets are allowed in the pick up line or in the building due to allergies, and the fact that many children this age are frightened by animals.

Clothing

Dress your child with crafts and active play in mind. Paints, crayons and glue may stain. The children will be playing outside whenever possible. Please dress them appropriately, including the proper shoes. Sandals, flip flops, platform or heeled shoes, and crocs should not be worn to school, as they pose a threat of injury on the playground. Tennis shoes are appropriate school wear. Outer garments, including gloves/mittens, hats, scarves, etc. should be clearly marked with your child's full name.

PLEASE-NO Umbrellas OR Backpacks with Wheels!

Discipline Policy

The Preschool/PDO will follow a "timeout" method of discipline:

Step 1: Give the child a warning and explain the consequences of not heeding the warning.

Step 2: Follow through with a time out if necessary. A time out chair will be used for 2 or 3 minutes by the child. The chair will be removed from the group, but in sight of the teacher/ caregiver.

Step 3: If a child has three time outs in one day or is so disruptive that the class cannot function, the child will have time out with the Director in the Director's office.

Under no circumstances will the staff of the Preschool or PDO strike a child. Conferences between the parent and staff will be scheduled when the best interests of the child require it.

Dismissal Policy

The Noblesville Methodist Preschool and PDO reserves the right to remove a child from enrollment if that child displays continued disruptive behavior, including but not limited to, excessive biting, fighting or tantrums. The director shall act upon the teacher's recommendation. Tuition will be refunded for the remainder of the month in which the action is taken, if tuition is current. Registration fees will not be refunded.

Cubbies

Each child will have a cubby in the classroom to store his/her belongings; this will contain notes, calendars, etc. for each child. Belongings will need to be taken home after each session.

PDO Lunches

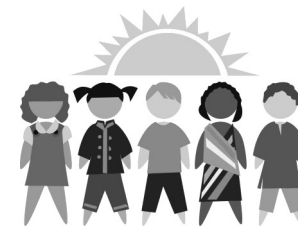
A lunch (including beverage and silverware) needs to be brought every PDO session. We can not refrigerate these so please take this into consideration when packing the lunches. All opened leftovers will be thrown away unless parents request otherwise. Parents of infants and toddlers, please include a sippy cup packed in your child's lunch.

Preschool Lunch Guidelines

There is no access to appliances to heat meals. Containers should be easy for children to open. **No soft drinks.** Sandwiches, finger food and pre-cut veggies and fruit are appropriate. Food items with multiple steps in building a lunch are time consuming and usually messy for the children (i.e. "lunchable" pizzas).

Closing Remarks

We will be giving every effort toward providing the best possible care for your child. We want this first "school" like experience to be a good one, and we want your children to have fun! Arrivals and Departures

Special consideration is given to make this as smooth as possible for the children. Please bring your child directly to the classroom. The child must then be signed in, including an emergency contact person and phone number. At the end of the session please check cubbies for papers and sign your child out. If a different person is transporting your child, this must be in writing and given directly to the caregiver. We can only release your child to an adult.

Enrollment

We follow the guidelines established by the Noblesville Public Schools to determine placement in classes.

Ducks	Five months
Bears	18 months
Chipmunks	Three years old by January 31
Lunch Bunch	Children enrolled in 3, 4 or 5 year old preschool.

Enrollment will take place in February. Enrollment to fill vacancies will be taken from a waiting list or on a first come, first served basis.

Diapers and Toilet Training

Children wearing diapers need to bring in a well-stocked diaper bag to the classroom. Please mark your child's name on each diaper. Children who are toilet-trained need to bring a change of clothes. All diaper bags and extra clothes need to be taken home after each session.

Class Times

The doors to the building will open at 8:55 a.m. The classrooms will open at 9:00 a.m.

Tuition

2 Year Olds	\$66/Month \$15.00 Supply Fee
3 Year Olds	\$100/Month \$25.00 Supply Fee
Pre-K a.m.	\$120/Month \$35.00 Supply Fee
Pre-K Alternate	\$220/Month \$50.00 Supply Fee
Pre-K Enrichment	\$275/Month \$55.00 Supply Fee

Your first month's tuition (September) and your last month's tuition (May) are both due and payable by September 1. The remaining 7 tuition payments will be due by the 1st of October, November, December, January, February, March and April. A late fee of \$1.00/day will be charged after the 10th of the month beginning with the October payment. NO tuition refunds will be given after March 1. **Tuition Express** will begin October 1st for all payments.

Enrollment

We follow the guidelines established by the Noblesville Public Schools to determine placement in classes.

- 2 Year Olds must be 2 on or before Aug 1.
- 3 Year Olds should be 3 on or before Aug 1, and toilet trained, no pull-ups.
- Pre-K should be 4 on or before Aug 1.

Arrival

To help your child have a more effective day, please ensure that your child gets a good night's sleep, eats a good meal and goes to the bathroom before school. Please walk your child to the classroom each day. There are coat hooks outside the classroom door. Please assist your child in hanging coats, etc. on these hooks. Each child will have a cubby inside the room where they may place personal items, such as show and tell. Your child should not bring toys to school, except as a special show and tell item.

Departure

Parents are to park their cars out front, NOT under the awning or along the curb and come to the front door of the church. DO NOT COME IN. A staff member will meet you outside. Pets may NOT greet their children at the door.

We need parents, who have children in the 2's, 3's, Pre-K's and Pre-K Enrichment to carry a sign to the front door when picking up their children. This sign should have all the names of the children who will ride in your car and their teacher's name. Each class is assigned a different color. Please line up with your class color.

Reuniting a child with a parent/caregiver at pick up is very exciting for them, so let's make this time cell phone fee!

Late Pick Up Fee for Preschool/PDO

If you fail to pick up your child on time, a fee of \$1 per minute up to \$20 will be charged. Please keep in mind that pickup times are:

Reports and Conferences

Conferences are the best opportunity for following your child's progress and are helpful to the teacher in understanding your child. Conferences are scheduled for 3's, Pre-K's, and Pre-K Enrichments.

Field Trips

Field trips are special educational times for your child. No siblings are allowed on preschool field trips. Each child will require a chaperone on trips.

Tuition*

One day per week	\$89/ Month
Two days per week	\$178/ Month
Three days per week	\$267/ Month
Four days per week	\$356/ Month
Extended Day	\$46/ Month per Session

Supply Fee: One day/week, \$25.00/year. Two days/week, \$50.00 per year.

Your first month's tuition (August) and your last month's tuition (May) are both due and payable July 15– August 15. The remaining 7 tuition payments will be due by the 1st of October, November, December, January, February, March and April. A late fee or \$1.00/day will be charged after the 10th of the month beginning with the October payment. This year we will begin using ***Tuition Express beginning in October.***

*Accounts over two months past due will be reviewed. Unless arrangements are made, the student may be dismissed.
